These items are distributed every month to more than 600 needy people in our community. We are asking you to bring your personal items/food collection to our next meeting on August 8th. Both Tom S. and Kay C. have offered to deliver these items. An email was sent out asking for members to join Tom and Kay and shelve the items at Journeys when they are delivered. Let's make this a service project. We are also looking for a member to be our liaison between Journey's and our fraternity. Please think about this as Journey's will continue to be a focus from here on.

At our August gathering we will also have Patty B. come at 6:30 p.m. to talk about Hopeful Beginnings and the needs of their baby closet. In the fall we will be doing a semiannual clothing drive with the focus on fall-winter clothing in sizes 2T-5T. Again, be on the lookout now for sales on these clothing sizes as this will be our October Outreach Project.

In August, our Spiritual Assistant Jerry will present a study of the Liturgy of the Hours psalms (per fraternity request). He will begin with one psalm and then pass the baton and let someone else do research and present on another psalm at a following gathering. Everyone will be involved. He will be available to help anyone with this project when it is their turn.

The council has been busy and we are open for any comments or questions. Call us. The council has also decided to meet every month, instead of bimonthly.

Also, please call me if you are unable to attend any of our gatherings. We are expected to gather in fraternity, have formation, have liturgy, socialize and serve. This is the game plan of our founder, St. Francis.
